# Dallas Dhu Distillery

Dallas Dhu Distillery is situated one mile south of Forres off the A940. The site consists of a historic whisky distillery built in 1898 with an audio-visual presentation.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.

### Potential hazards at Dallas Dhu Distillery

#### Pedestrian access to site

- Risk from other moving traffic in coach park.

#### External Hazards

- Some banks in the grounds may become slippery.

#### Internal Hazards

- Take care on sets of stairs.
- Barriers at high levels.
- Surfaces mostly even underfoot.
