



## Hazard Information for teachers

# Trinity House

Trinity House is situated at 99 Kirkgate in Leith.. The site consists of an outstanding collection of military memorabilia inside an elegant Georgian house.

It is the responsibility of teachers and group leaders to complete a risk assessment prior to any site visit with a group. This is a requirement of most education authorities. The following information is intended as a preparatory tool and does not replace a teacher's or group leader's own risk assessment.

Please be aware that changes in weather may affect the risks inherent in an outdoor site. Pupils should dress for outdoors.

### Potential hazards at Trinity House

#### Pedestrian access to site

- Parking is in the nearby Lidl carpark. Risk from other moving traffic in the car park.

#### External Hazards

- Outside courtyard may become slippery in wet weather.

#### Internal Hazards

- Stairs with handrails lead to vaults and to upper floors.
- Low doorways at access to vaults.
